WCC OFFERS CAREER EXPLORATION & JOB SEARCH CLASS

Bellingham, WA, March 2, 2012 — If you're interested in figuring out what to do next in your life, the Career/ Life Planning Courses offered by Turning Point, the Life Transitions Program at Whatcom Community College (WCC), may be for you. Two classes will be offered again this spring, one in the evening and one during the day. The day class runs 8:30 a.m.-noon, Monday-Friday, April 2-19 at WCC. The evening class runs 5:30-8:30 p.m. Tuesdays and Thursdays, April 10-May 31 at the College. The classes are designed for those who are in transition, no longer supported by income from another, and seeking support and direction in either career or educational needs.

Participants will identify their skills, look at the job market, explore career choices, learn interviewing and resume-writing techniques, and develop a practical plan to achieve career and life success. The atmosphere is warm and supportive, and the instructional style is fun and interactive.

The class will meet at the college, located at 237 W. Kellogg Road. Registration and instructor permission is required.
